

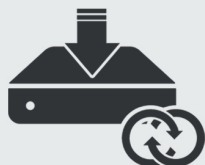

Dashboard

The dashboard provides a comprehensive overview of system health and service status. It includes sections for Primary Services (DEP Accounts, Email settings, LDAP Extraction status, VPP Tokens), Sync Status (DEP Accounts, VPP Tokens, Smart Group Count), and Server Performance Status (Drive Space, CPU Usage, RAM). Performance metrics are visualized with donut charts and gauges.

Easily see the status of critical systems and services, and create custom alerts.

Inventory

The inventory interface allows users to create and execute custom queries. The example query filters for 'Windows 7' on 'Any Client'. The interface includes search filters, criteria selection, and options to manage groups.

Create customized queries to know and monitor what you have with integrated inventory.

Imaging

The imaging interface displays a list of clients and filesets. It includes search filters, a table of client details (Name, ID, Model), and a table of fileset details (Name, Size). Associations between filesets and clients are also shown.

One stop imaging provides a fast and easy way to image OS X and Windows machines.

Kiosk

The kiosk interface displays a list of software applications with their installation status. It includes a search bar, a list of items, and buttons for 'Install' and 'Uninstall'. A 'Top Downloads' section is also visible at the bottom.
