

Q: What types of media does the 4-in-1 card reader support?

A: The 4-in-1 card reader supports XD, Memory Stick, Multimedia Card (MMC) and Secure Digital (SD).

Q: What is an ExpressCard slot?

A: ExpressCard is a new hardware standard replacing PC cards (also known as PCMICA or Card Bus cards). ExpressCards allow support of PCI Express and USB 2.0 speeds through ExpressCard slots. The cards are hot-pluggable, similar to USB 2.0, and come in either 34mm or 54mm sizes.

Q: What is the average battery life for the SP15R?

A: The 6-cell battery lasts about 3.5 hours with normal usage.

Q: What does "DVDRW" suggest when it relates to the internal optical drive on the SP15R?

A: Basically, this means that the drive is capable of burning or recording most CD and DVD formats. It is also capable of reading or playing back most CD and DVD formats.

Q: How do I enable Bluetooth on my SP15R?

A: Bluetooth is enabled by selecting the FN+F11 key combination, allowing you to cycle through the following options: Bluetooth off/Bluetooth on. The "on" status will be blue (Bluetooth) LED to the left of the power button.
