1 Day Getting Started with Chromebooks & Google Tools - Onsite

The perfect jumping off point for teachers that are generally new to Chromebook and Google Apps for Education. A Certified Google Education Trainer/Teacher will spend a day on-site providing a hands on overview of Chromebook devices and the Google eco-system. Participants will be introduced to the core Google Apps for Education and other resources and will also learn strategies for managing a 1:1 classroom.

2 Day Getting Started with Chromebooks & Google Tools - Onsite

A two day workshop for teachers that are generally new to Chromebooks and Google Apps for Education. A Certified Google Education Trainer/ Teacher will spend the first day providing a hands on overview of Chromebook devices and the Google eco-system. Participants will be introduced to the core Google Apps for Education and other resources and will also learn strategies for managing a 1:1 environment. The second day will build on the tools introduced in day one and focus on strategies that leverage those tools to advance curricular goals and create collaborative learning environments.

1 Day Google Administration Console- Onsite.

A Google Certified Trainer will spend one-day onsite training IT Staff and/or other designees on the setup and usability of the Google Admin Console. Needs vary by school and the agenda will be customized in advance to fit the specific needs of the participants.

1 Day Google Apps Deeper Dive Curriculum Integration Workshops - Onsite

These one-day curriculum integration workshops take a deeper dive into just one or two Google Apps and focus on assisting teachers in developing techniques that work well with their specific curriculum, skill level, and teaching style. Schools will choose, in advance, up to two apps per day on which to focus the agenda. Participants will explore ways to manage the tools for collaboration and learn best practice strategies for incorporating them into their curriculum. Participants will be provided time to learn and create materials they can utilize in their classroom right away. A two day Train-the-Trainer format is available to districts looking to leverage internal resources to train a large group of teachers'.

Participants will also discover how to navigate the entire Google Classroom platform, how to change discussion settings and how Google Classroom integrates with Google Drive files. Participants will be provided time to learn and will be prepared to implement the platform in their classrooms right away. The half day agenda can be delivered twice during the day and will have the greatest impact on audiences of 25 and fewer.

Just-In-Time Remote Technology Integration Mentoring for Teachers (3 Hour Blocks)

A three-hour block of one-on-one classroom technology integration guidance from an expert skilled in your particular area of interest or concern. Time will be utilized in one hour increments. Support can be facilitated via phone, chat or video conference and enhanced with screen sharing capability where appropriate. Sessions can be recorded and archived for later reference. A discovery call will be conducted in advance to pair the teacher with the most appropriate Mentor. Multiple blocks may be purchased and combined to support groups of teachers or more complex, longer term support.

They will also have two live Google Hangout sessions led by the course instructor to help foster growth and learning as well as sharing and collaboration. The course will be hosted on a Google Site. Learning activities and outcomes:

- Time to develop up to five Google Play for Education projects for immediate integration
- Develop a culminating activity for reflection and summation
- Autonomy to design relevant materials
- Participation in Google Hangouts with cohort
- Sharing resources using Google+ communities
- Portfolio of resources to include in professional development plans
